Hi Everyone,

We are excited about our third annual "Youth Choir Music Mission Golf Tournament". Many of you have supported this tournament in the past and we hope that you are making plans to attend again this year. All of your contributions will be used to buy materials for our mission events in Michigan, provide scholarship money for choir members, and to ease the cost of transportation, housing, and meals during our tour. We are excited about this year's tour. We will be guests of First Presbyterian Church in Ann Arbor Michigan, singing programs and providing mission work in Holland, MI, Lexington, KY and Nashville, TN.

Last year we had 54 players. We look forward to having 18 foursomes in this year's tournament. If you have friends that play, please encourage them to join us.

Enclosed is a registration form to pay by check and mail to the given address or you can go online by visiting ogumc.org and pay by credit card. Click donate, then go to other ministries, and put in the word "golf" to make your payment.

The following are specifics that you need to know regarding this year's tournament.

1. When you come to the gate at Stone Mountain Park, tell them you are there to play the Oak Grove Golf Tournament. They will let you in free of charge.
2. Once you are through the gate, take your first (immediate) left and follow that road to the Stone Mountain Golf Club which will be about a quarter of a mile on your right.
3. You can take your clubs to the bag drop and then go park your car.
4. You do not need to go into the clubhouse to register. We will have tables set up behind the clubhouse where you can confirm that you are present and/or pay if you haven't already done so.
5. Many of you purchase mulligans and they will be available to you once again (2 @ \$10.00 each). You may purchase your mulligans when you prepay your greens fee, or one of our Youth will be glad to assist you if you wish to pay upon arrival.
6. Following check in, please find your cart by checking the placards on the front of each cart. Your team's carts will be parked together. Please indicate which players on your team will be riding together and I can have those two names on the same cart.
7. We have sack lunches and drinks for each player. Our Youth will be handing those out to you.
8. We will have several players that will be coming directly from church. Others will have the opportunity to come early. The range is open and balls are available to you. Please note that the putting green is directly in front of the clubhouse, but the driving range is probably a quarter of a mile away. **If you go to the range, please be back to the clubhouse by 12:55. We need to start on time.**
9. At 12:55, Nick Cesarini, our tournament coordinator, will talk through the rules sheet which will be attached to the steering wheel of each cart.
10. You will then go to your assigned hole and start your round. Sunset is at 6:36 p.m. Please time your round as if you were the team that is playing behind you. No one enjoys slow play!
11. Following your round, please proceed to the back of the clubhouse and turn in your scorecard so that we may post your scores.
12. The clubhouse will be open for you to sit and talk, and have a bite to eat or drink at that time.
13. Prizes will be awarded in the clubhouse following the tournament.
